"We've got so many fascinating and entertaining things to offer people this year", comments Parrsboro Creative Executive Director Robert More, "and we're very excited to be presenting the 2019 festival in partnership with the Parrsboro Board Of Trade which is led by Rosemary Rowntree who is chock full of inventive ideas".

10 Days In October already has some great events in the line-up: two dinner theatre evenings at The Ottawa House Museum about the 1919 crash in Parrsboro by the trans-Atlantic airplane, the Handley Page; Oktoberfest at The Hall; a family treasure hunt; first feature films; the return of the popular garden club event with a guest speaker; music concerts at the Two Islands Brewery; an opening celebration at the Bandstand with artisan displays and food fare with specialty dishes from local restaurants,

horse-drawn hay-rides, fun photo booth, live music, and buskers doing juggling and magic acts.

Other events in negotiation are a magical Night Market, a family fun day at the Fundy Geological Museum; an exhibition of models of 1800's ships by the Age of Sail Museum, and a presentation of dance and songs by Mi'kmaw artists in traditional costumes. And for art lovers, there will be plenty of unique and exciting work at venues around the town that will feature both professional

and community artists.

"It's a wonderful mix", says Parrsboro resident and fabric artist, Krista Odlin, "it really adds so much excitement to the fall and there are so many things to experience - it makes me proud to be part of such a wonderful creative community."
