## Driver License Renewal Now Available Online

Nova Scotians can now access a new online service to make it easier and faster to renew regular driver, motorcycle and farm tractor licences. Drivers can use the new service if they: have a licence that expires on or before Dec. 31; do not have outstanding fines or suspensions; have not recently changed their address online or do not need to change their address and have a regular (Class 5), motorcycle (Class 6) and farm tractor (Class 8)

An electronic or printed renewal confirmation will be provided so people can continue to drive with their previous licence until their new card arrives in the mail. Driver licences can still be renewed at Access Nova Scotia centres by calling to make an appointment or waiting in line. ## Nurse Practitioner Incentive Expanded

Government is expanding a program designed to help ensure Nova Scotia has the nurse practitioners it needs to help improve Nova Scotians' access to primary care. The Nurse Practitioner Education Incentive covers the salaries of six registered nurses while they attend Dalhousie University's two-year Master of Nursing nurse practitioner program full-time. In return, recipients will commit to work in one of several designated communities for five years.

An expression of interest will be issued to those already accepted to Dalhousie's nurse practitioner program, family all-ages stream. Recipients will be selected based on whether they live in or are affiliated with one of the designated communities and are willing to relocate upon completion of the program. Recipients must commit to work in one of the designated communities for five years. This expands on the 10 spaces announced in 2018. Three of those participants have graduated and are working as nurse practitioners

in Digby, Cumberland County and Victoria County.

Four more will graduate this fall and will practice in Shelburne, Cape Breton County, Inverness and Pictou, and the final three will graduate next May and will practice in Cumberland County, Digby and Sheet Harbour.

The eligible geographic areas for the additional six spaces are: Truro and Pugwash with a 60 km radius of surrounding area. Other areas also with a 60 km radius are Inverness, Caledonia, Shelburne and Guysborough or Canso.

An arrangement between Dalhousie and Cape Breton University will continue to allow students in Cape Breton to complete some program requirements locally, minimizing the need to travel to Halifax.

## Testing Strategy for Post-Secondary Students

After consultation with the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, Premier Stephen McNeil, announced on August 20 post-secondary students to all university and NSCC entering the province from outside Atlantic Canada will require testing for COVID-19 along with 14 days of self-isolation. Students inside the Atlantic bubble only need to self-isolate if they travelled outside the bubble in the past 14 days.

Students will be tested at three different times during their 14-day isolation period. Even with negative test results, the full 14-day self-isolation

must be completed. Students cannot attend in-person classes until their testing and self-isolation are complete and they have received negative test results.

Universities and NSCC are contacting their students directly with information about these requirements and the process for getting tested. Students should direct any question to their institutions. Nova Scotia Health is setting up additional testing centres where needed to test students during their self-isolation

Government is also enhancing the border form for everyone arriving in the

province from outside the Atlantic bubble. The new Nova Scotia Safe Check-in allows better data collection and tracking. A digital check-in will soon replace follow up phone calls to ensure people are self-isolating. The Nova Scotia Safe Check-in is at <https://novascotia.ca/coronavirus/travel/>
