

Colchester's Polling Locations for October 17TH

Guy Wheeler, Colchester's municipal election returning officer, has announced the locations of regular polling locations for October 17th municipal election. He outlined the results of an updated study at council's committee meeting on Thursday, August 13th.

The locations are as follows:

District 1: Polling Division - Community Location

- 1A - Brookside, Bible Hill (West) Bible Hill Fire Hall
- 1B - Vimy Court Bible Hill Vimy Court

District 2:

- 2A - Truro Heights area at Cobequid Fire Hall # 1
- 2B - Lower Truro area at Cobequid Fire Hall #1
- 2C - Old Barns, Clifton, Beaver Brook, Princeport, Green Oaks will vote at Cobequid Fire Hall #2
- 2D - Green Creek, Pleasant Valley, Shortts Lake will vote at Brookfield Sportsplex
- 2E - Riverside, Fort Ellis voters must go to Stewiacke Community Centre

District 3:

- 3A - Hilden area at Hilden Fire Hall
- 3B - Brookfield area at Brookfield Sportsplex
- 3C - Alton, Brentwood, Forest Glen areas at Stewiacke Community Centre
- 3D - Elk Court area at Brookfield Elk Court

District 4:

- 4A - Eastville, Burnside, Pembroke, Newton Mills, Upper Stewiacke, Meadowvale, Otter Brook, Crossroads areas will vote at Upper Stewiacke Fire Hall
- 4B - Cloverdale, Birch Hill, South Branch, Middle Stewiacke, Halfway Brook areas at Middle Stewiacke Rec Centre
- 4C - West St. Andrews, Wittenburg, Lanesville, East Stewiacke, MacKay Siding areas at Wittenburg Baptist Church
- 4D - Gays River, Pine Grove, Shubenacadie East, Coldstream area voters go to Wittenburg Baptist Church.

District 5:

- 5A - Salmon River, Murray Siding, Harmony, Camden will vote at Salmon River Fire Hall.



District 6:

- 6A - Greenfield, Manganese Mines, East Mountain, Valley (North) will vote at Crossroads Baptist Church

District 7:

- 7A - Mattatall Lake, Lake Road, French River, Bayhead, West Tatamagouche will vote at Tatamagouche Fire Hall.

- 7B - Tatamagouche, Barrachois, Sand Point voters will go to Tatamagouche Fire Hall.

- 7C - Waldegrave, Waughs River, Denmark, Middleton, Keble, Brule Point, Brule, Brule Shore area voters will vote at Tatamagouche Fire Hall.

- 7D - East New Annan, Central New Annan, Byers Lake, Millbrook, Debert Lake, West New Annan, Tatamagouche Mountain, Kavanaugh Mills, Warwick Mtn, Oliver, New Truro Rd will also vote at Tatamagouche Fire Hall.

- 7E - West Earltown, Earltown, East Earltown, Balfron, Balmoral Mills, The Falls will vote at Earltown Community Centre.

- 7F - Willow Lodge Tatamagouche will vote at Willow Lodge.

District 8:

- 8A - Onslow Mountain area voters go to North River Fire Hall.

- 8B - Upper Onslow, North River areas at North River Fire Hall.

- 8C - Nuttby, McCallum Settlement, Upper North River, Central North River, Upper Brookside areas vote at North River Fire Hall

- 8D - Riversdale, Kemptown, Upper Kemptown areas at Kemptown Community Centre

District 9:

- 9A - East Folly Mountain, Debert voters will go to Admin Building Debert Air Industrial Park

- 9B - Lower Onslow, Central Onslow areas at Onslow Belmont Fire Hall.

- 9C - Belmont, Moose Lake, Crowes Mills areas at On-

slow Belmont Fire Hall.
9D - Debert Court Debert voting will be held at Debert Court.

District 10:

- 10A - Lynn, Lower Five Islands, Five Islands areas at Five Islands Fire Hall.

- 10B - Simpson Lake, McCormack Lake, Lower Economy, Carrs Brook, Economy, Upper Economy areas at Economy Recreation Centre.

- 10C - Little Bass River, Bass River, Castlereagh, Montrose, Five Houses, Portapique area voters will go to Bass River Fire Hall.

- 10D - Lornevale, Londonderry, Hart Lake, Folly Lake, Folly Mountain, Londonderry Station, East Village area will vote at Londonderry Community Centre

- 10E - Highland Village, Great Village, Glenholme, Little Dyke areas at Great Village Fire Hall.

- 10F - Lower Debert, Masstown areas will vote at Masstown United Church.

District 11:

- 11A - Bible Hill (East), Valley (South) will vote at Colchester Christian Academy.

Civic address of each polling location, voting times as well as locations and times for the four Advance Polling dates will be listed on the Voter Registration Card sent to every voter who has been previously registered.

Although the voters list has been prepared, corrections or additions may be made upon your application in person, by telephone, mail, fax, or e-mail. Electors may find out if they are on the list of electors by contacting the Returning Office between 8:30 am - 4:30 pm Monday to Friday, before September 30, 2020.

Colchester's Advance Polling Locations

To help increase participation in the October 17th municipal election, voters will have a total of five days to vote. Regular voting day is October 17th, but over the summer Colchester Council held a special meeting to start the process of a revisions to the bylaws to add two extra advance polling dates.

This year voters can select from four advance polling dates on October 8, 13, 14 & 15. In an update to Council committee on August 13th, Guy Wheeler, returning officer confirmed Advance Poll Locations as follows: District 1: Bible Hill Fire Hall; District 2: Cobequid Fire Hall #1; District 3: Hilden Fire Hall; District 4: Middle Stewiacke Recreation Centre; District 5: Salmon River Fire Hall; District 6: Bible Hill Fire Hall; District 7: Tatamagouche Fire Hall; District 8: North River Fire Hall; District 9: Admin Building Debert Air Industrial Park; District 10: Great

Village Fire Hall and District 11: Bible Hill Fire Hall.

1-11 Court House

The Court House in the municipal building at 1 Church Street will be used as an Advanced Poll location for all four advance polling dates on October 8, 13, 14 & 15. Registered voters from all eleven districts

and vote at the court house location.
