Municipal and *Conseil scolaire acadien provincial* (CSAP)

October 19, 2024

The upcoming general election will allow eligible residents in the Municipality of Colchester to vote for their choice of:

Mayor
 One Councillor
 One member of the Conseil scolaire acadien (CSAP)

and

Electors in Districts, 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, and 11 will also receive and be asked to vote on the following Plebiscite:

“Do you support a safely managed urban deer bow/crossbow hunt to control and reduce the urban deer population in and around your community?”

Introducing E-Voting

The Municipality of Colchester is offering Electronic Voting for the first time. Municipalities in Nova Scotia have been using electronic voting since 2008 and it has proven to be a safe and secure method of voting, while providing more opportunities to vote. Electors will experience:

- Less travel - no need to travel to a voting location to cast a ballot.
- An extended period to cast your vote.
- The flexibility to vote from anywhere at any time.
- Easier for electors with disabilities, sickness, and/or out of the area to vote.
- Convenient and accessible voting during times of uncertainty (the pandemic).

Electors can vote online, via the Internet using a device such as a computer, laptop, tablet, iPad or smart phone
 or
 By telephone (cell or landline).

Electors will receive a Voter Information Letter, by the first week of October, that will contain an elector's unique voter PIN and internet address that will link to the voting website. A Toll Free number is also included for those who wish to vote by telephone.

Electronic Voting Period

Monday October 7, 2024, at 08:30am and runs continually until 7:00pm, Saturday October 19, 2024.

Assistance In Voting

Electors that require assistance in Voting Electronically may visit the Returning Office at 1 Church St., Truro, from:

October 7, 2024 through to October 18, 2024 between the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm (weekdays, excluding holidays)
 and
 Saturday, October 19, 2024, between the hours of 8:00am and 7:00pm
