


Canada's First Offshore Wind Energy Areas Designated

dustry that will provide long-term energy security and generational economic benefits for Nova Scotians.

"With some of the top wind speeds in the world, Nova Scotia has the potential to become a clean energy superpower," said Premier Tim Houston. "With the right infrastructure, we'll have the opportunity to send our wind west to power other parts of Canada. By becoming an energy exporter, we can secure long-term prosperity for Nova Scotians."

The designation comes after the public was asked for feedback on five proposed areas in the spring. The input contributed to the decisions to designate four areas and make the French Bank and Sydney Bight areas slightly smaller.

The next step in developing offshore wind energy is identifying the parcels within the designated areas that will be included in the first call for bids later this year. The aim is to license five gigawatts of offshore wind by 2030. This will set the stage for future offshore wind development and position Nova Scotia to become an exporter of clean energy.

After the first round of licences are awarded, four other areas identified in the January 2025 regional assessment of offshore wind development will be revisited. They include Western/Emerald Bank, which was the other area shortlisted in the spring.

States Midwest providing transmission planning services for three major utilities. A registered professional engineer and Fellow of the Institution of Engineering and Technology, Johnston holds an engineering degree from Oxford University and completed his business education at Cranfield University and Harvard Business School.

"This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity," said Johnston. "This is about more than just managing the grid—NSIESO is about enabling the energy transformation in Nova Scotia. We have an opportunity to reshape our electricity system around clean and reliable energy, and as a not-for-profit organization we are singularly focused on long-term value for Nova Scotians. tion, and to work alongside many who are already driving this change."

NSIESO was created following the recommendations of the 2024 Clean Electricity Solutions Task Force. It will play a key role in the province's energy transition to renewables. NSIESO will be responsible for grid planning, interconnection assessments, competitive procurement, and ultimately, real-time operations of the province's bulk electricity sys-

tem.

"We're just getting started," added Reid. "We're establishing a modern, independent operator—one that welcomes clean energy investment, encourages competition, and puts Nova Scotians first." Johnston will be based in Halifax and started on August 18, 2025. The appointment of the CEO by NSIESO's Board of Directors follows a national search led by recruitment firm KBRS.
